## **HARDRES COURT ROAD, CANTERBURY**

### **TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF DRIVING**

Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 – Section 14 (2)

**Kent County Council gives notice that Hardres Court Road, Canterbury will be closed to through traffic, on or after 12th February 2023 for up to 5 days.**

**The road will be closed at Upper Hardres.**

**The alternative route is via Hardres Court Road, Street End, B2068 Street End, Stone Street, Curtis Lane, Bossingham Road, The Street, Hardres Court Road and vice versa.**

**This closure is necessary to enable burst water main repairs to be carried out by South East Water.**

**This Notice applies when the relevant signs and barriers are on site and is valid for a period of no more than 21 days.**
