TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF DRIVING

Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 – Section 14 (2)

Kent County Council gives notice that Manns Hill, Bossingham will be closed to through traffic, on or after 7th March 2022 for up to 21 days.

The road will be closed outside Farncombe.

The alternative route is via Bossingham Road, Fryarne Park and Petts Bottom Road.

This closure is necessary to enable burst water main repairs to be carried out by South East Water.

This Notice applies when the relevant signs and barriers are on site and is valid for a period of no more than 21 days.
