(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING)
THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984
TEMPORARY ORDER MAY 2023

To allow pole replacement works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Stone Street, Petham.

A closure is planned from 24th May 2023, for up to two days, between the hours of 09.30 and 15.30, or where stated on a valid Permit (BC411WDLFT75V001-01 - Openreach). The scheduled dates may vary for these works with appropriate signage displayed on site and the works will be displayed on [One.Network](#)

Stone Street will be closed in the vicinity of Chequers Hill, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The closure is required for the safety of the public and workforce while pole replacement works are undertaken by Openreach.

The alternative route for any through traffic is via Stone Street, Street End, Nackington Road, Old Dover Road, St Lawrence Road, New Dover Road, Dover Road, Dover Road Slip, A2, Dover Road, Barham Slip Eastbound off, A2 J A260/B2046 Join SE Canterbury, Box Iron Road, Old Dover Road, Canterbury Road, The Street, Canterbury Road, Spitfire Way, Canterbury Road, Churchill Avenue, Cherry Garden Avenue, Cheriton Road, Cheriton High Street, Ashford Road, Stanford Intersection/Stanford Bypass, Stone Street and vice versa.
