STONE STREET, PETHAM

TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF DRIVING

Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 – Section 14 (2)

Kent County Council gives notice that Stone Street, Petham will be closed to through traffic, on or after 22nd February 2023 for up to 3 days.

The road will be closed outside Pengarth, Stone Street.

Please note, there will be no direct access between Hythe / A20 / M20 to and from Canterbury using Stone Street during these works.

The alternative route is via B2068 Stone Street, Stanford Bypass, Stanford Intersection, A20 Ashford Road, Cheriton Interchange, B2046 Cheriton Approach, Cheriton High Street, Cheriton Road, A2034 Cherry Garden Avenue, A259 Churchill Avenue, A260 Canterbury Road, White Horse Hill, Spitfire Way, Canterbury Road, The Street, Canterbury Road, Old Dover Road, A2 Dover Road, A2050 Dover Road, New Dover Road, St Lawrence Road, Old Dover Road, B2068 Nackington Road, Faussett Hill, Street End and Stone Street and vice versa.

This closure is necessary to enable water pipe repairs to be carried out by South East Water.

This Notice applies when the relevant signs and barriers are on site and is valid for a period of no more than 21 days.
