TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF DRIVING

Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 – Section 14 (2)

Kent County Council gives notice that Rectory Lane & Hardres Court Road, Upper Hardres will be closed to through traffic, on or after 7th February 2024 for up to 10 days.

The road will be closed in the vicinity of Manor House.

The alternative route is via:

Rectory Lane - Northbound - Pett Bottom Road, Tapleys Hill, Hardres Court Road.

Southbound - Rectory Lane, Pett Bottom Road, Manns Hill, The Street, Hardres Court Road.

Hardres Court Road - Hardres Court Road, The Street, Bossingham Road, Minnis Lane, Curtis Lane, Stone Street and Street End and vice versa.

This closure is necessary to enable water pipe repairs to be carried out by South East Water.

This Notice applies when the relevant signs and barriers are on site and is valid for a period of no more than 21 days.
