(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

TEMPORARY ORDER JULY 2023

Kent County Council works.

To allow carriageway resurfacing to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Stone Street, Petham.

A closure is planned from 19.00 hours on 11th October 2023, with estimated completion by 05.00 hours on 12th October 2023. The scheduled dates may vary for these works with appropriate signage displayed on site and the works will be displayed on One.Network

Stone Street will be closed between Hogg Lane and Catt's Farm, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The closure is required for the safety of the public and workforce while carriageway resurfacing works are undertaken by Kent County Council.

The alternative route for any through traffic is via B2068 Stone Street, Stanford Bypass, Stanford Intersection, A20 Ashford Road, Cheriton Interchange, B2064 Cheriton Approach, Cheriton High Street, Cheriton Road, A2034 Cherry Garden Avenue, A259 Churchill Avenue, A260 Canterbury Road, White Horse Hill, Spitfire Way, Canterbury Road, The Street, Canterbury Road, Old Dover Road, A2 Dover Road, A2050 Dover Road, New Dover Road, St Lawrence Road, Old Dover Road, B2068 Nackington Road, Faussett Hill, Street End and Stone Street. Motorists will be required to follow the National Highways diversion from Barham Interchange to Whitfield Roundabout.

Pedestrian access will be maintained during the works.
