

Expanding our Neighbourhood Plan to cover the whole Parish of Upper Hardres

What are the benefits of a Neighbourhood Plan for Upper Hardres Parish?

- It enables our community to define how we want our parish to develop.
- It means future planning applications will need to align with our plan, preventing future planning applications being dealt with on an individual basis.
- It will increase the new "Community Infrastructure Levy (CIL)" funds available in our parish from 15% to 25%.
